The Burnet County Emergency Services District #6 conducted a published meeting at 6:00 p.m. at 606 Avenue U (Marble Falls Volunteer Fire Dept.) on August 18, 2026.

After deliberating on the proposed Budget for the year 2026 -2027, the Board unanimously approved such Budget.

A PROPOSED TAX RATE discussion was called.

A hand vote was taken to approve a proposed tax rate of 10 cents per hundred which is lower than the Voter Approval Rate of \$00.1041 per \$100.

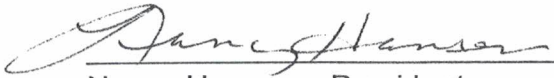
